Selectmen voted to include a warrant article at the Special Town Meeting for December 1, 2022, at 7:00pm, at the Orland Community Center, to see if the town will vote to appropriate \$586.66 from Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recover Funds (aka American Rescue Plan Act or ARPA funds) received by the Town from federal government to compensate the Orland Historical Society for loss of membership dues revenue in 2020 due to the pandemic. Voted 3 – 0
4. Discussion on New Orland Fire Station. Selectmen voted to hold a Special Town Meeting Referendum election to vote on a New Orland Fire Station, on Tuesday, January 24, 2023, from 8am-8pm, at the Orland Community Center. Voted 3 – 0
5. Selectmen voted to hold a Public Hearing on the proposed New Orland Fire Station on Thursday, December 15, 2022, at 7pm, at the Orland Community Center. Voted 3 – 0
6. Selectmen voted to approve the updated Appendices A-G of the General Assistance Ordinance for October 1, 2022 to September 30, 2023. Voted 3 – 0
7. Discussion with Bart McGraw on the Hancock County Planning Commission.
8. Selectmen voted to cancel the Selectmen’s meeting on October 20, 2022, due to not have a quorum.
